

**NATIONAL CHARTER FOR  
FEMINIST MAJORITY LEADERSHIP CAMPUS AFFILIATES**

**As an affiliate, our feminist campus organization agrees to abide by the following principles and standards:**

- Equality between women and men, girls and boys, and constitutional and statutory measures to achieve equality.
- Safe, legal and accessible abortion, and family planning, including Medicaid funding and access to minors.
- Achieving civil rights for all people, including affirmative action programs for women and people of color.
- Lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender rights.
- Non-discrimination on the basis of sex, gender, race, sexual orientation, socio-economic status, religion, ethnicity, age, marital status, national origin, size, or disability.
- Non-violence and the elimination violence against women.
- Programs directed at the preservation of the environment, clean air, and water, the elimination of smog, toxic and hazardous waste, chemical and nuclear weaponry.
- Workers' collective bargaining, pay equity, and the end of sweatshops.
- The organization is a non-profit, non-sectarian, non-partisan, voluntary organization affiliated with the Feminist Majority Foundation.

**The purpose of the Feminist Majority Leadership Campus Affiliate is:**

1. To establish a broad constituency to work in pursuit of feminist ideals – social, political, and economic equality for women and men, girls and boys.
2. To study and take action on national, state, local, and campus feminist issues and concerns.
3. To provide leadership and career building opportunities for feminist students.
4. To educate the college/university community about feminist issues.
5. To enhance the feminist community on campus.

**The Feminist Majority Leadership Campus Affiliate will be responsible for:**

Designating a committee, officer or member to communicate regularly with the Feminist Majority Foundation, including updates at the beginning and end of each semester. Participating in the national and global campaigns of the Feminist Majority Foundation or participating in at least one campus campaign per school year (see Campus Organizer for current campus campaigns).

**The Feminist Majority Foundation will provide the affiliate with:**

- Access to trained Campus Organizers, campus campaign materials, monthly take action mailings, the *Choices: Study & Action Manual*, membership to [www.feministcampus.org](http://www.feministcampus.org), a subscription to *Choices* e-zines, networking opportunities, and national and local leadership trainings.
- Use of the name Feminist Majority Leadership Affiliate or another name. The group will be considered officially affiliated with FMF when it has submitted the signed and dated affiliate form and a copy of its current constitution. FMF will then send the group a certificate of affiliation and a welcome packet.
- Feminist Majority Leadership Affiliates have the opportunity to raise funds for their campus group through FMF t-shirt sales, FMF Walks for Women's Lives, and *Ms.* magazine sales.
